1. Grading

- Course grades will be calculated as follows:
70% Exams/Quizzes/Projects
20% Homework/Notebook
10% Participation

2. Exams/Quizzes/Projects

- Each exam is worth 100 points and is cumulative.
- Exam dates are announced well in advance (at least one week before the exam).
- Quizzes may be announced or unannounced and are usually worth no more than 50 points each.

3. Homework/Notebook

- A three-ring binder is *required* and must be brought to class every day; it must be kept neat and organized and it may be checked at any time.
- All classwork and homework must be done on loose-leaf paper in your binder and may be collected. (*Late homework will not be accepted.*)
- When homework is reviewed in class, you are expected to correct any errors you may have made.

- Students are expected to participate in class discussions and to respond loudly and clearly.
- Excessive lateness disrupts the class, detracts from your class participation, and thus will *lower your grade*.
